Love (Ep. 5:2)

a sure mark of salvation (1 Cor. 13:1-8)

Joy (Phil. 4:4)

exhilaration of a heart right with God

Peace (Jn. 14:1, Rm. 8:28)

tranquillity of a mind in having a saving relationship with God

Patience (Col. 3:12)

tolerance and longsuffering that endures injuries inflicted by other,
calm willingness to accept irritating or painful situations

Kindness (2 Tm. 2:24)

tender concern for others

Goodness (Ga. 6:10)

excellence in sweetness and kindness

Faithfulness (1 Cor. 4:1-2)

loyalty and trustworthiness

Gentleness (1 Tm. 6:11)

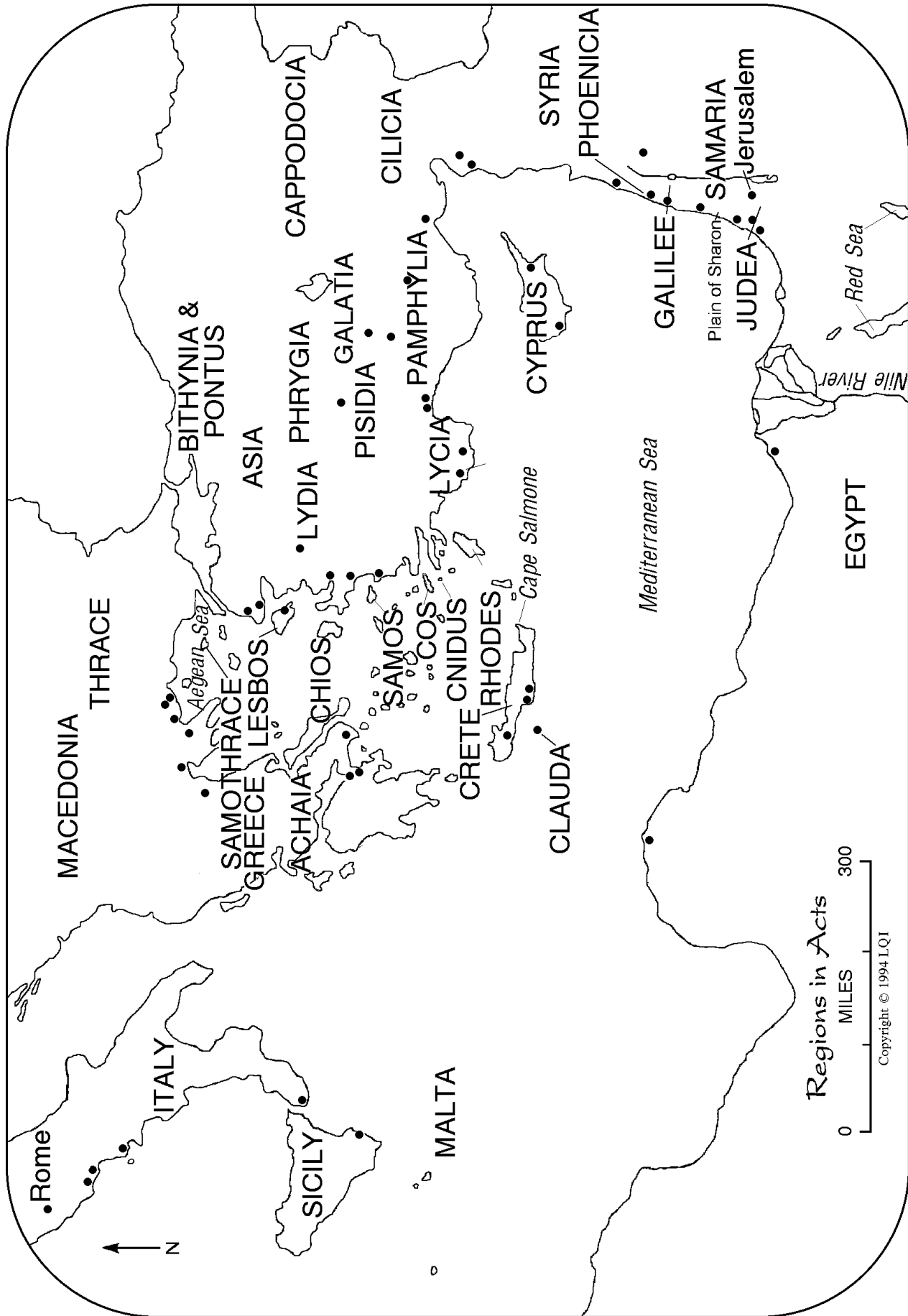
an inward grace of soul that accepts God's dealings with us as good

Self-control (1 Co. 9:25, 2 Pt. 1:5-6)

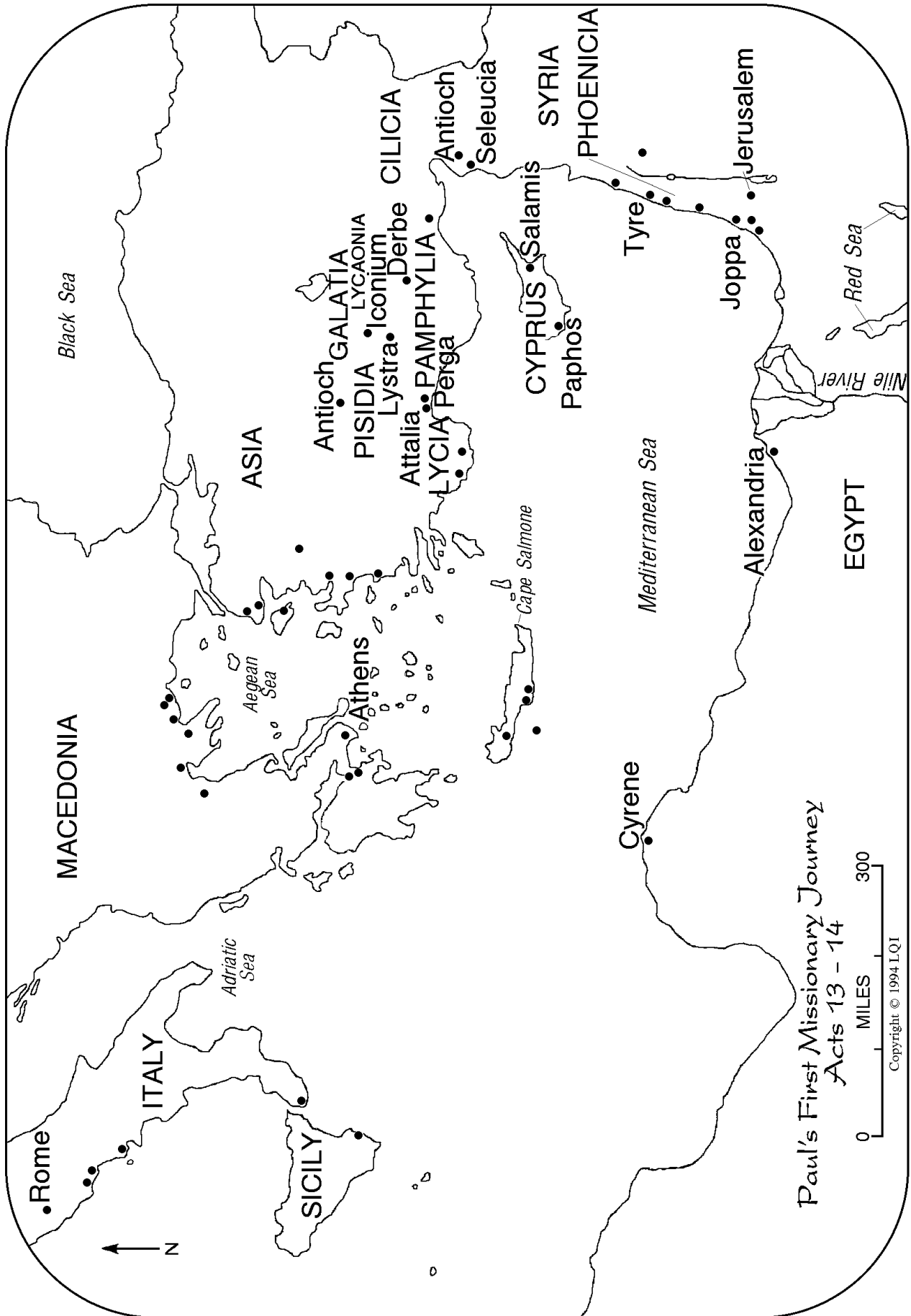
restraining of passions and appetites

The Holy Ghost (Spirit) does not need a system of law to produce these things.

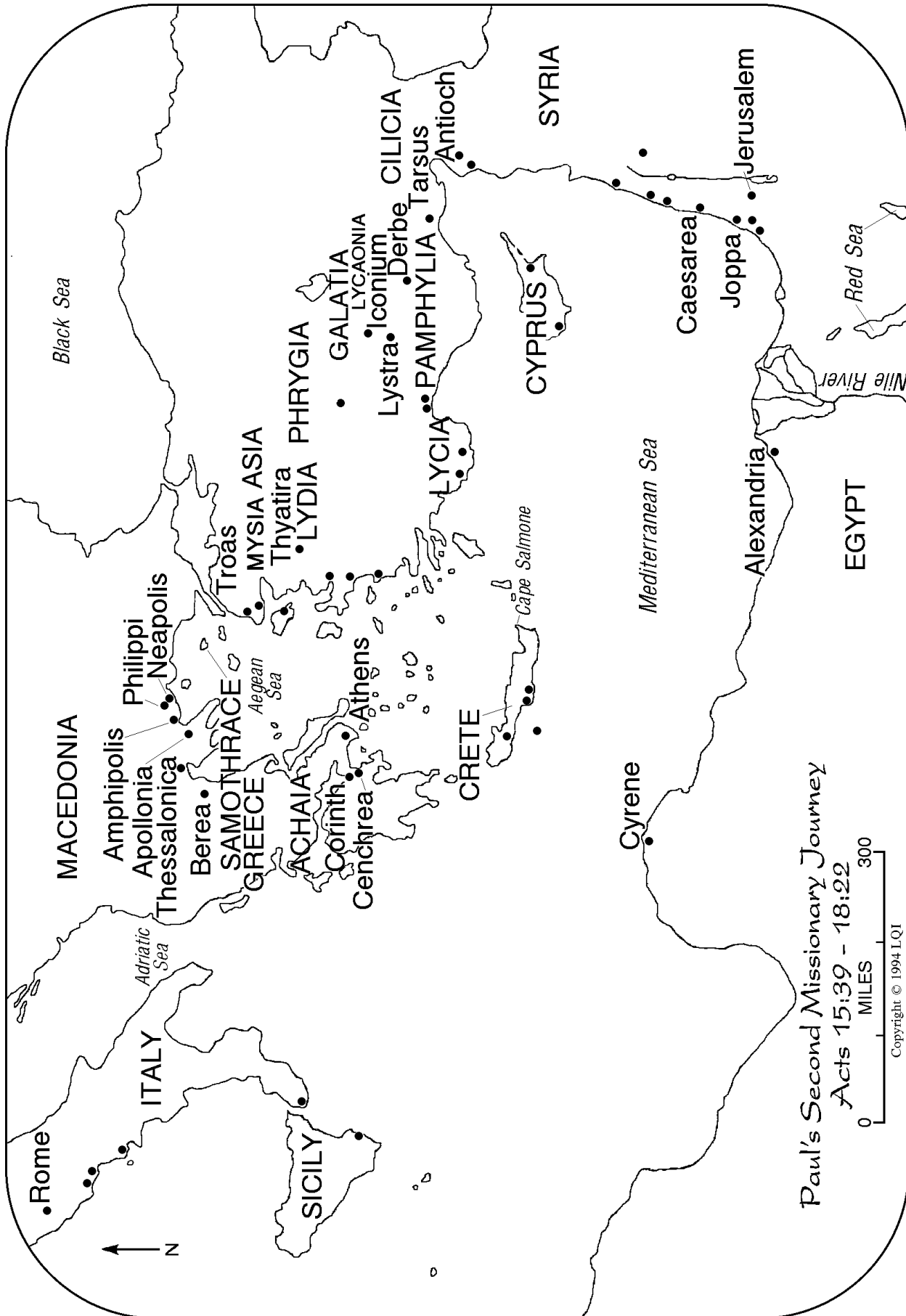
Map 1: Regions in Acts



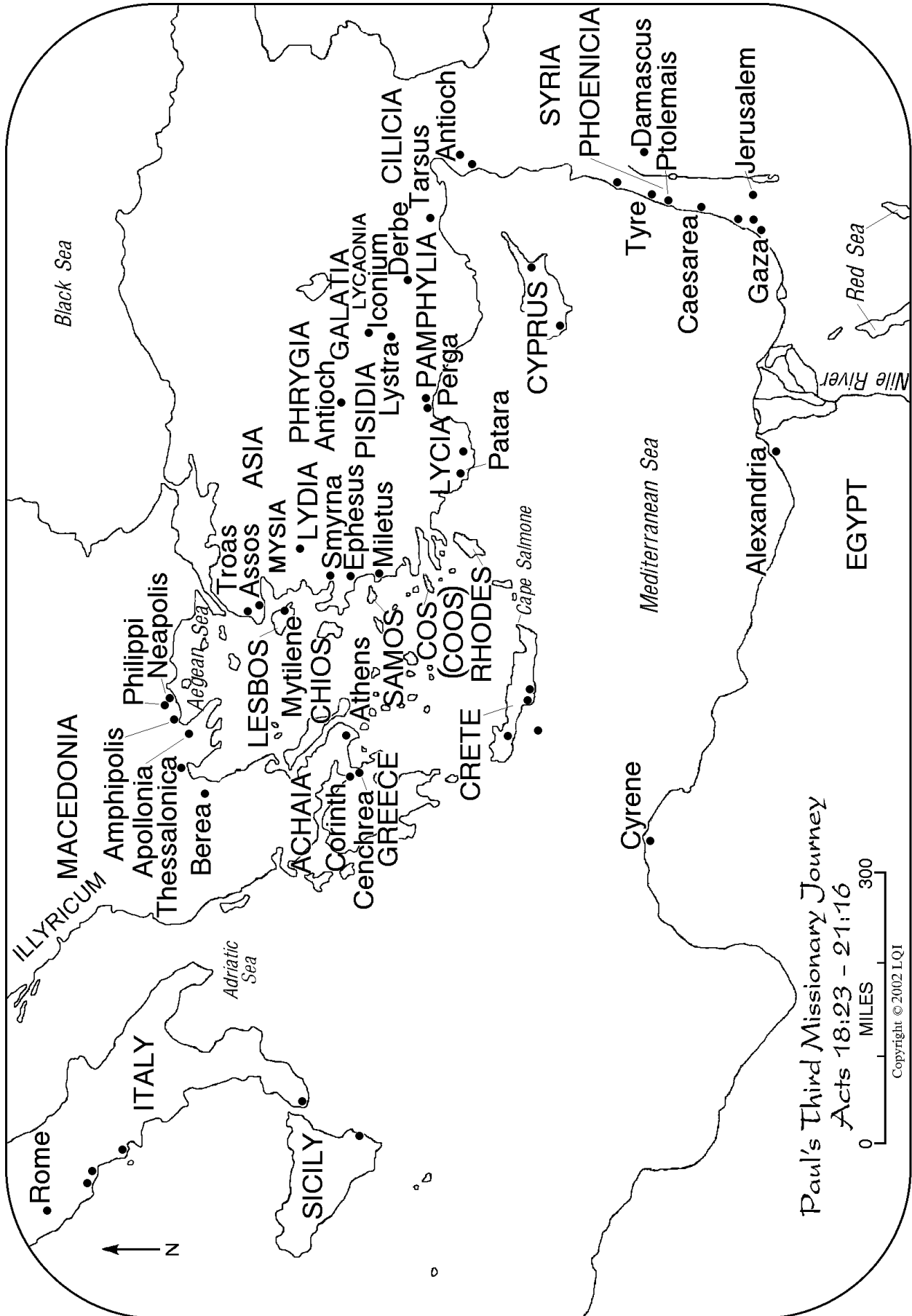
Map 2: Paul's First Journey



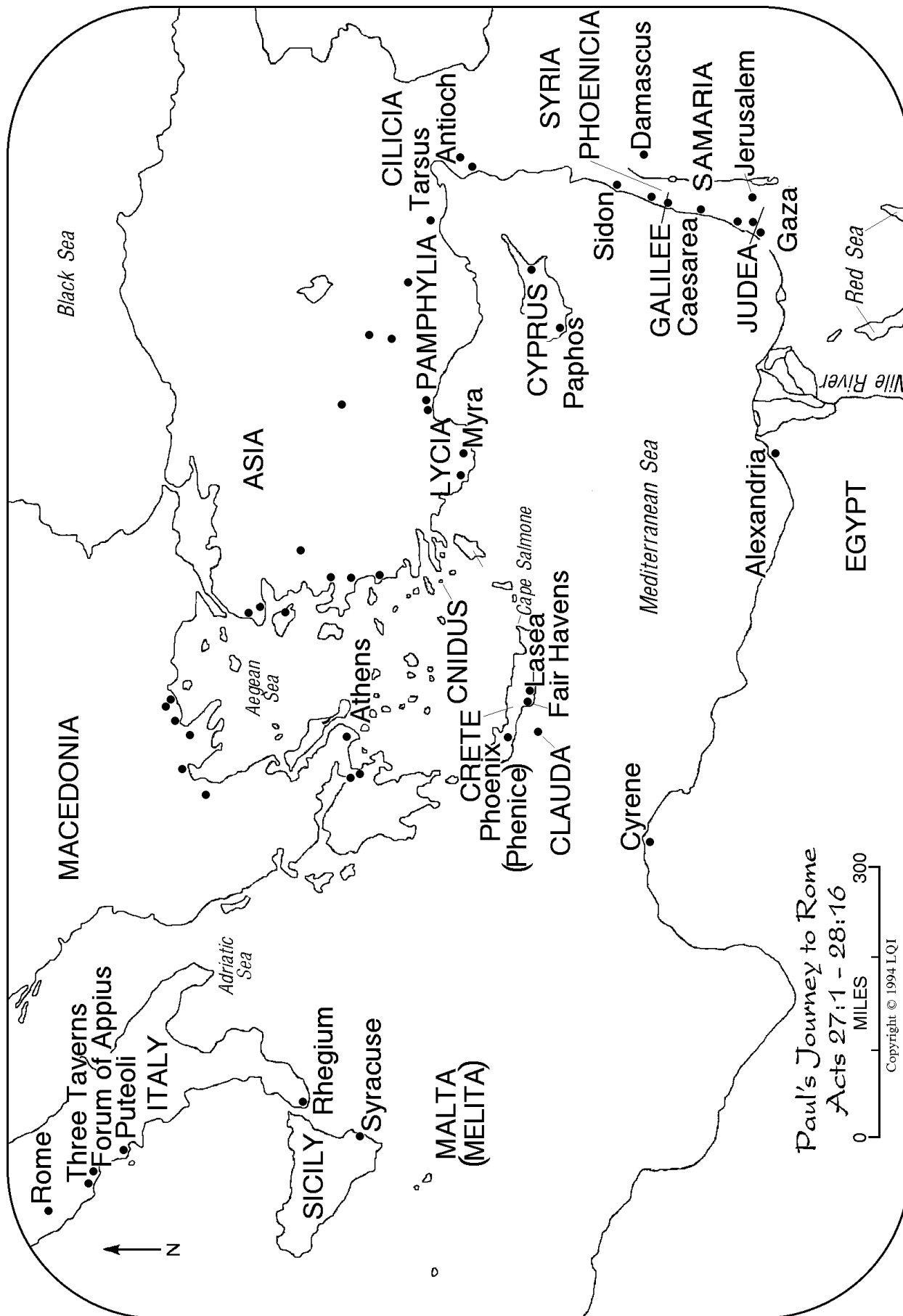
Map 3: Paul's Second Journey



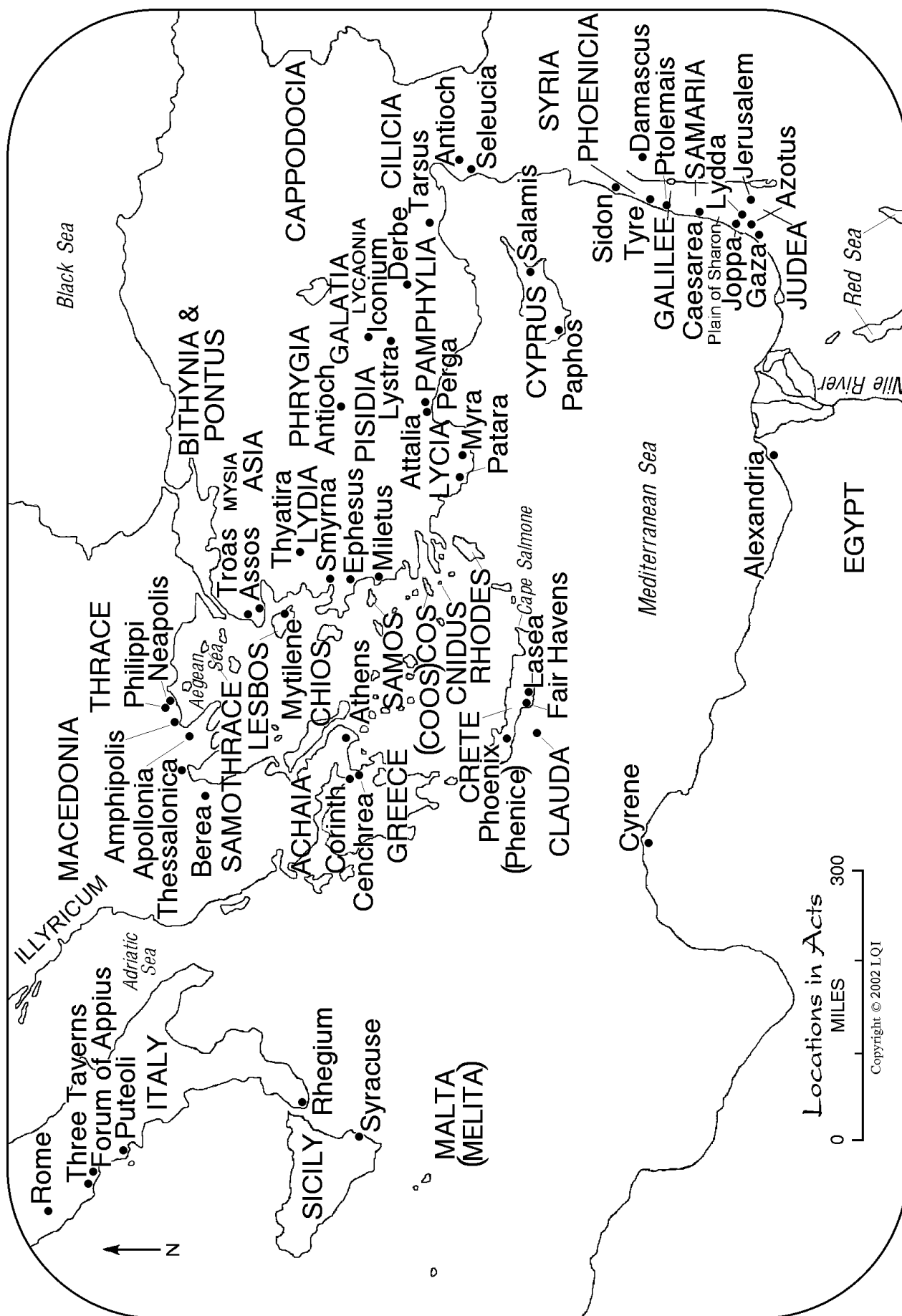
Map 4: Paul's Third Journey



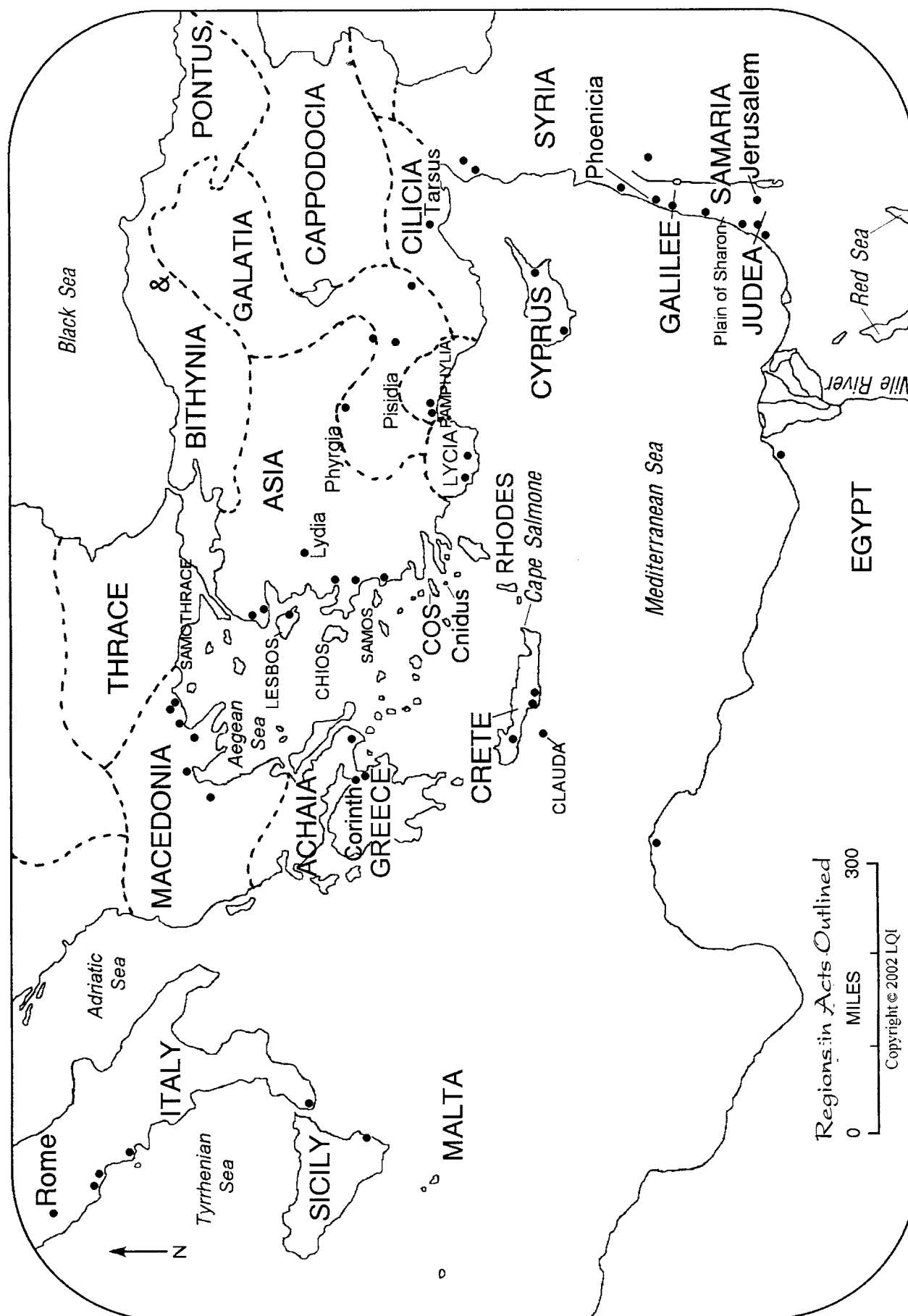
Map 5: Paul's Journey to Rome
