Purpose

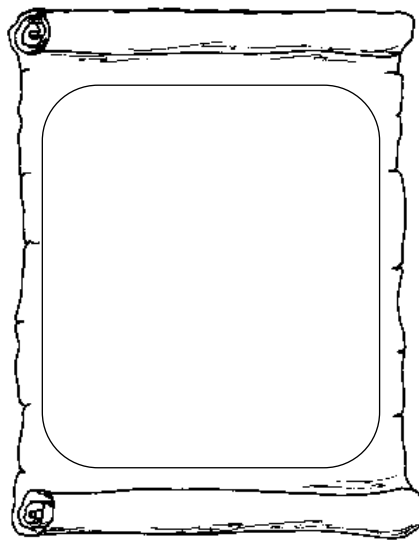
Week 5 of 13: This project pictures the truths Paul presents about God and His Son Jesus Christ to the believers in Corinth.

Preparation

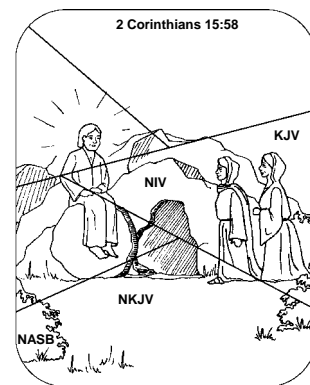
- Gather the pages and supplies indicated above.
- Cut apart the **Jesus Is Risen Puzzle** with Verses.

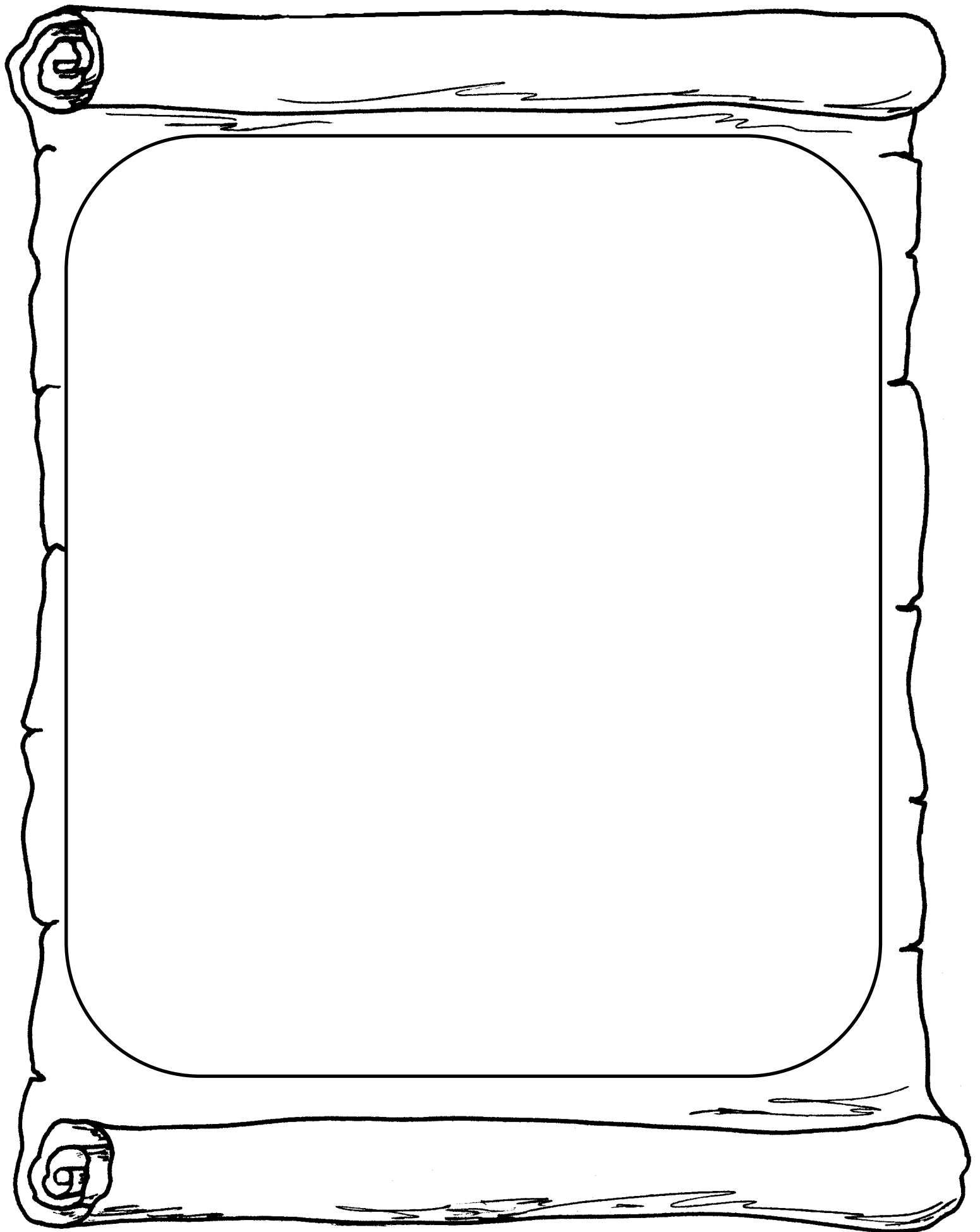
Process

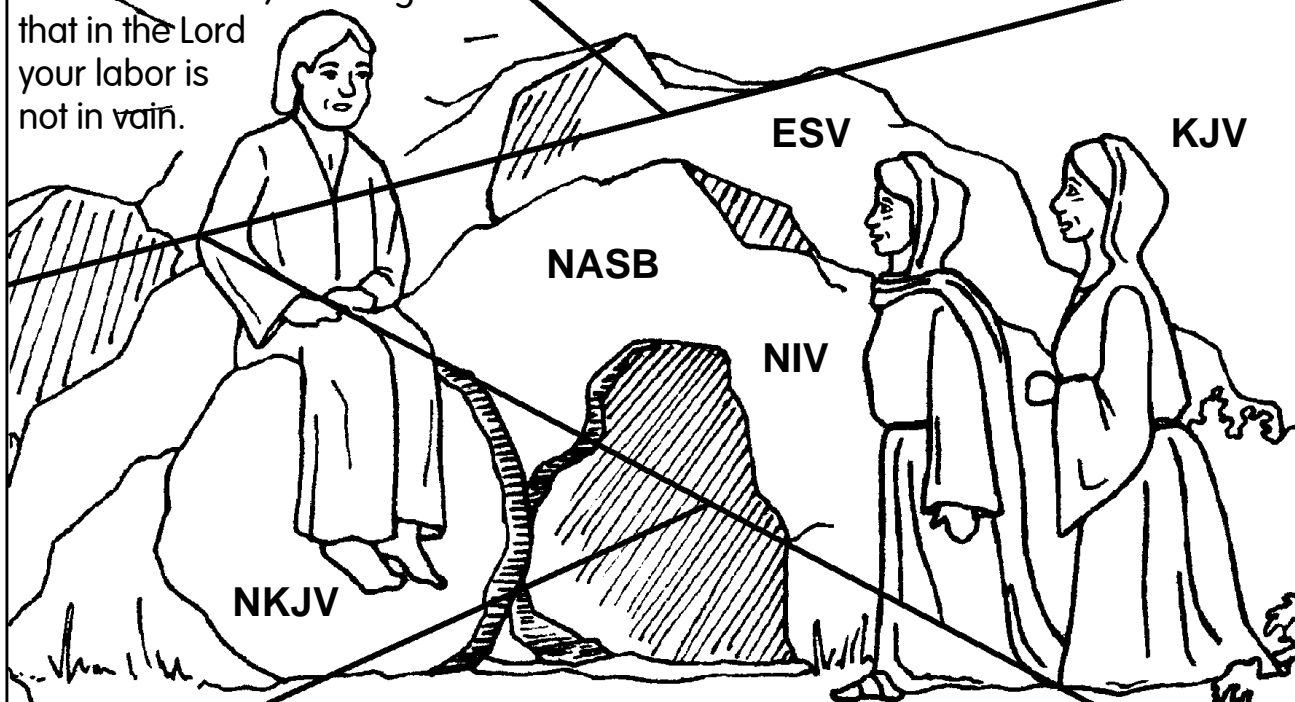
