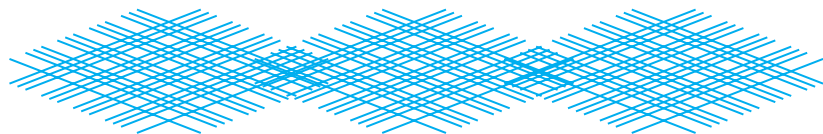




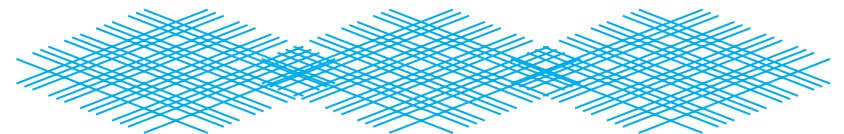

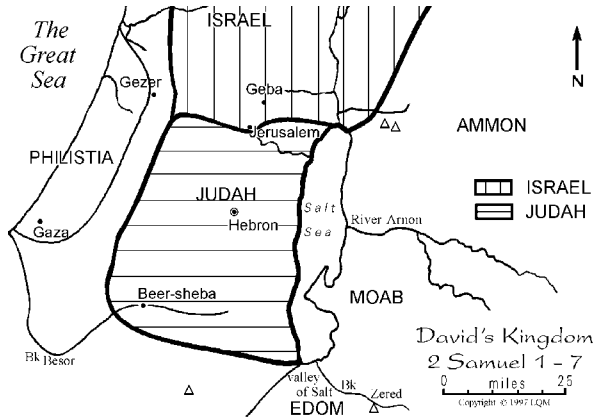

## 2 Samuel 2:4a

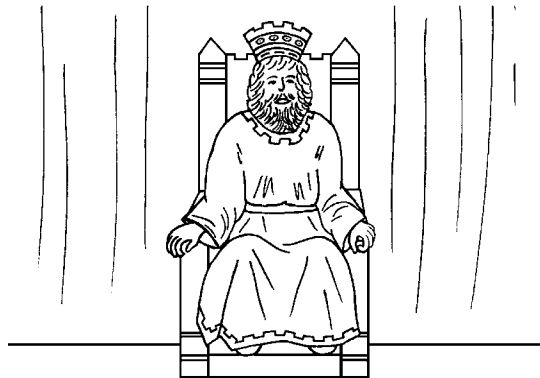

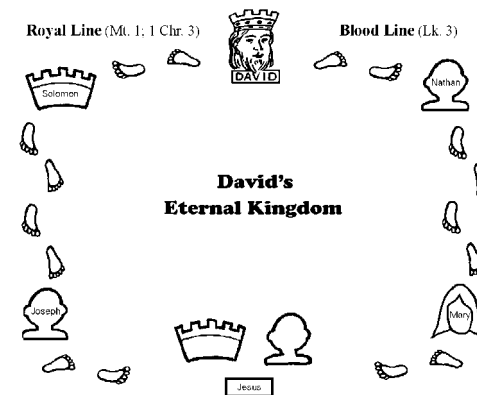
## 1 Samuel 8 - 2 Samuel 2 - ESV

- SE27 **Hebrews 9:27** And just as it is appointed for man to die once and after this comes judgment.
- SE28 **Hebrews 10:11-12** And every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God,
