
Luke 10:38-42 - Mary and Martha

Matthew 7:13-23 - Beware of Wolves




15 Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. 16 You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles?" 17 Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. 18 A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit. 19

Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. 20 Therefore by their fruits you will know them.



- None who go to her return,
 Nor do they regain the paths of life--
- 20. So you may walk in the way of goodness, And keep to the paths of righteousness.
- 21. For the upright will dwell in the land, And the blameless will remain in it;
- 22. But the wicked will be cut off from the earth, And the unfaithful will be uprooted from it.
